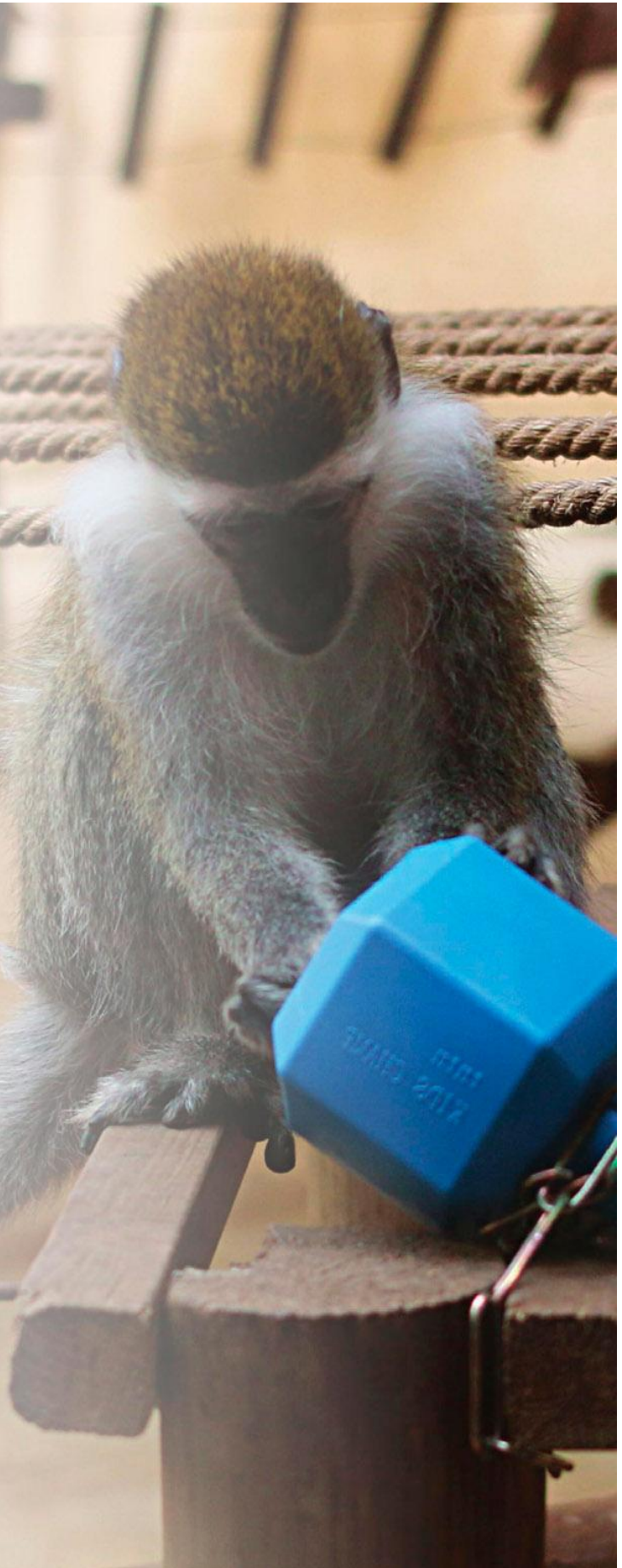

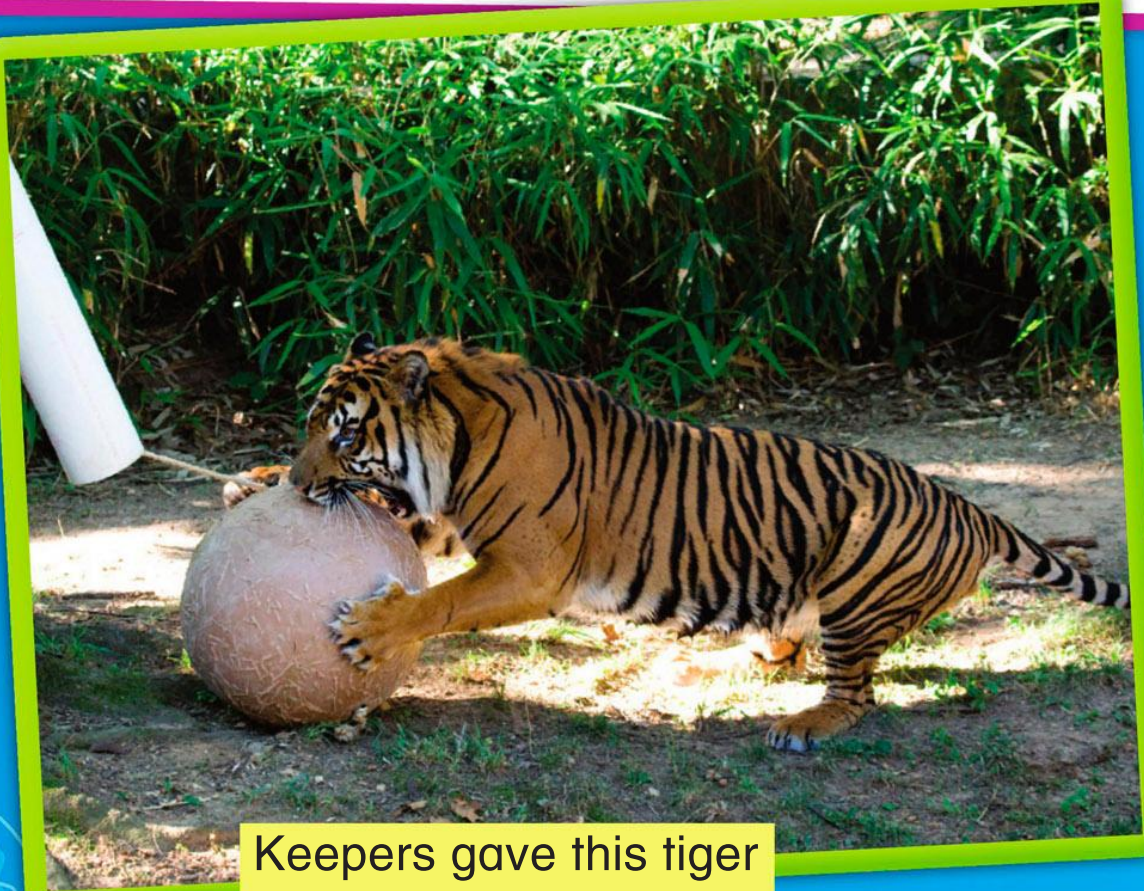

Keepers gave this tiger a ball to play with.

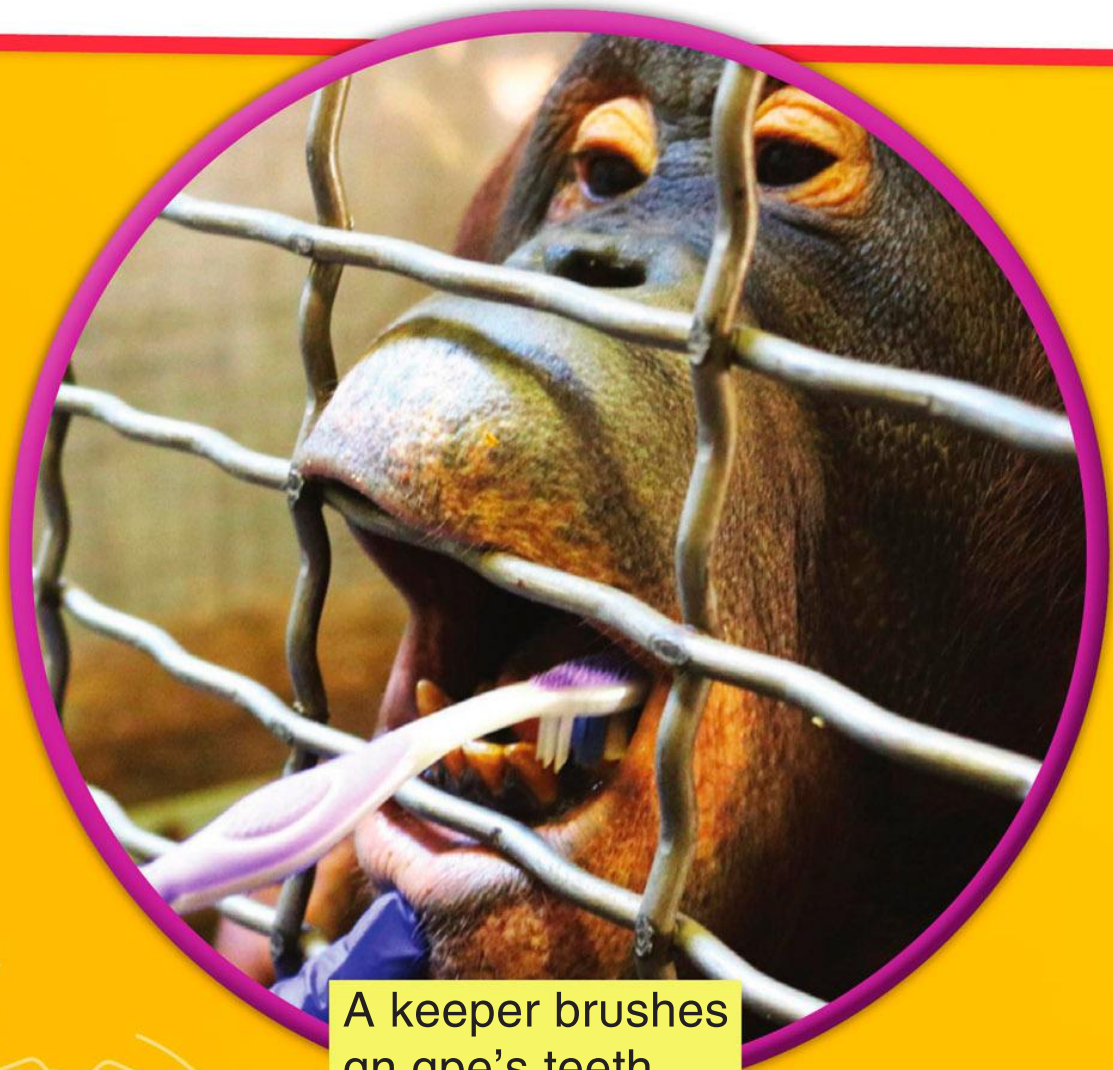




Bear cubs play at the Smithsonian's National Zoo.
