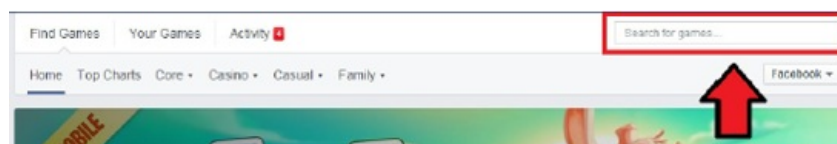

Introduction

Plants vs Zombies: Garden Warfare 2 is a 3-D person shooter game where you battle enemy zombies (or plants). You play as a plant, or even a zombie, and each character is unique with their own weapons and special abilities you can utilize to take down enemies.

The Characters

Similar to the old game, there are eight classes, and now there are six additional classes. Each class is different and has different abilities. All of the characters and their variants have their own levels. As you play the game, your character gains experience. Enough experience and you'll level up. Completing quests are one way to gain experience.

The Plants



- Peashooter – Ah the good old pea shooter spits out peas, a chili bean grenade, and you can move super faster and jump super high. You can even become a Gatling turret.
- Sunflower - The friendly dancing sunflowers. Remember them? Now, they heal your teammates and shoot a sunbeam that does major damage. The downside of their sunbeam is that it makes them unable to move, but considering how powerful the beam is, it's a fair trade.
- Cactus - The cactus has a drone that it sends out to do airstrikes. It's more of a long-range fighter, that can place down Tallnuts and potato mines in various places.
- Chomper - This plant kills zombies by swallowing them whole. Also, they bite

and spray goo on enemies.

- o Chompers can bury themselves underground and swallow a zombie who walks over them.
- o Chomper can spew goo on zombies to slow them down.
- Citron - The dreaded orange bounty hunter uses lasers to attack zombies. He deploys shields, block projectiles, and can duck into a ball that doubles as an attack. He also possesses an EMPeach, which he uses to stun zombies with.
- Rose - Rose is pretty neat. She can transform zombies into goats, slow them down, or vanish into a mist she creates to hide for a bit.
 - o During Herbal Assault, Rose can make portals that her teammates can teleport into.
- Kernel Corn - This guy shoots corn. A charged weapon called Shuck Shot can take down enemies, and he can send out a small airstrike called Butter Barrage. Kernel Corn is pretty awesome too as he can leap over top enemies while shooting out of his dual, corn-on-the-cob guns.

Zombies



- Soldier - Soldier zombies carry around assault rifle. Or sometimes he has a jet pack, stink bomb, or rocket launcher. Just depends on his mood.

- All-Star – He’s got a ton of health. He places down shields, throws exploding imps, and tackles plants. All in all, he’s pretty hard to take out.
- Engineer - This zombie rides a jackhammer around. He can also build portals in the Graveyards and Gardens game mode. His main weapon is a launcher that stuns plants and can do splash damage using mines and/or sonic grenades.
 - o Big Bold Blaster is a turret these zombies jump on. Let’s just say it lives up to its name.
- Scientist - He heals other zombies, much in the same way the sunflower heal plants. He can also create a healing station, teleport, or toss a healing grenade at his fellow zombies. He’s no weakling though; he also carries around a shot gun.
- Imp\Z-Mech - At first you’re a weak imp, but at least you have two guns and a whirlwind attack that lets you spin around and shoot. Oh and you have a gravity grenade that stops all plants from doing anything except shooting. But then you have a Mech.
 - o When in the Mech, his health goes up a lot and he has access to new abilities. In Mech mode the Imp’s health increases drastically and he obtains some new abilities. The abilities vary, but he can stomp on enemy plants and shoot missiles.
- Super Brainz - Just like his name implies, Super Brainz looks like a super hero and punches down enemies with his fists.
 - o This super zombie possesses a good bit of health compared to others and he has a Super Ultra Ball ability, which is a long-ranged attack. His Heroic Kick can kick through a hoard of enemies and with Turbo Twister he spins around like a tornado, knocking out enemies as he goes.
- Captain Deadbeard - The Captain is versatile in that his main weapon is both long and short ranged,
 - His Barrel Blast ability puts him in a barrel that blows up after a short period of time. The good Captain can also send out his parrot like Cactus sends out his drone.

Backyard Battleground

This is the battleground (shocking, right?). Here you play as plants or zombies. Visit the customization booth and switch which team you play for whenever you want. There's also multiplayer mode where you can play with up to three other players.

Below is a list of the major features of the base.

- The Mailbox - Here you'll get the latest news and you can get your rank rewards from previous games.
 - o You have until February 2017 to import characters.
- Customization Booth - Here you view and customize the game's characters. You can switch characters you play in the Backyard Battleground as well.
- Quest Board – Here you'll find quests for plants, zombies, and even the multiplayer mode. Completing quests gives you coins, stars, and pins.
 - o Stars have a variety of uses around the backyard, like placing cosmetics. Collecting enough pins will unlock the multiplayer portals, which helps you level up faster.
- Multiplayer Portal - Here you play others online, set up a private match, or go solo against an A.I.
 - o To play the online matchmaking games, you have to go here. Simply select the mode you want to play and then go through the portal to start playing.
- Sticker Shop - Use coins to buy sticker packs in the sticker shop.
 - o Sticker packs are used to unlock upgrades, characters, and more.
- You obtain coins by completing quests and playing the different game modes.

- Split-Screen - Add a player to the same console and play through any of the game modes. This only works on the PlayStation 4 and Xbox One, however.
- Stats Room - Take a look at the plants and zombie you've unlocked as well as your overall stats here. When a character reaches level ten, this is where you can promote them.
 - o Promoting brings your character back to level 1, but unlocks a title that other players will see when you kill them. A character can be promoted five times.
- Story Quests - These quests can be completed for both zombies and plants. You can find them in your quest log.
- Flag of Power - This is a flag in the middle of the Backyard Battleground that you can raise. It works with both zombies and plants, and raising the flag will bring waves of enemies to you.
