Getting Started

The game is most enjoyable with the sound turned on because it serves as a marker of where you left off the last time the players died. Some of the jumps that are required will have players jumping to the beat of the music. This makes the music very helpful during gameplay.

There are many different characters that can be unlocked. Some of the characters are available in the beginning on the game while others can be unlocked by completing tasks such as collecting coins or rating the game. Players can learn what needs to be done to unlock the characters by tapping the gold lock. The characters with silver locks are only available in the paid version of Geometry Dash.

Players are encouraged to switch between levels. When stuck on a level, switch to another level even if it is harder. Players will probably see some new obstacles that will help get back to the old level.

In addition to jumps, falls, and spikes, players should also be on the lookout for collectible goods as new characters are unlocked. There are other obstacles such as lava. Players can sit in the lava for no longer than a second before dying.

Tips

Follow the beat!

Try to play the game with the music and sounds enabled. Some of the levels are designed to follow the beat of the song. Players who are actively listening to the music can use it too.

Try to play this game with music and sounds enabled. The levels are sort of designed to go along with the beat of the song, and if you're actively listening to it, it might help you know when to jump. Of course, don't follow the beat the entire time – you'll jump right into your doom if you do so! So, if you're having trouble with the trickier successive jumps, trying going along with the beat.

Grab those coins!

Each level has giant golden coins hidden around the level for you to collect. You probably won't be able to collect all of them on your first play through as by the time you see one, it'll probably be too late to grab it. These things require hard memorization, so you're going to have to revisit levels and keep on the lookout.

Try out practice mode!

Have trouble with a level? Consider trying out practice mode. In practice mode, you play through the same exact level but you have the option to leave behind green diamonds. These diamonds act as checkpoints, so you can leave one before a particularly tricky segment to practice it as much as you like. Some of the customization options can be unlocked only through practice mode too!

Practice makes perfect!

Along with the aforementioned practice mode, Geometry Dash Meltdown is all about rote memorization. Play through the levels enough times and soon you'll know the whole layout from the back of your hand. Just keep playing and playing until it becomes second nature to you!

Take a break!

As the game demands your full attention, it's wise to take a break every now and then. You'll get frustrated pretty easily if you continue to die a lot, leading to even more deaths. Step back and take a break and regain yourself. Once you come back, you'll have all your concentration and you can begin anew!
