What You Need to Know

There is one kind of math that is used all of the time. In fact, it is hard to go through one whole day without it. Do you know what it might be? Money math!

There are four main kinds of coins. The **cent** sign (¢) is used when showing how much a coin is worth.

A **penny** is worth 1¢. A **nickel** is worth 5¢. A **dime** is worth 10¢. And a **quarter** is worth 25¢.



If you have 100¢, you have one **dollar**. The dollar sign (\$) is used to show dollars. It is much easier to carry a single dollar bill than it is to carry 100 pennies!
