Managing Time



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What Did You Do Today?

Are you having a good day? (I hope so!) Think about everything you have done since you woke up. Did you brush your teeth and eat breakfast? How did you get to school? Did you walk or take a bus? Or did somebody drive you?

Going Deeper

Now, let's think about other things you probably did today. Did you look at a computer, cell phone, or television? Did you read a book? (You've started at least one!) There are people who study how we spend our time. They use that information to help learn about people and **society**.





Time Before Clocks?

Before there were clocks, people watched the sun and the moon for clues about time. In the 1300s, the **mechanical** clock was developed. It measures time with gears and weights.



Wait a Minute!

Do you know how many minutes are in a day? We know there are 24 hours in a day and 60 minutes in each hour.

$$\begin{array}{c} 24 \\ \text{hours} \end{array} \times \begin{array}{c} 60 \\ \text{minutes} \end{array} = \mathbf{1440} \\ \text{per day} \qquad \qquad \text{per hour} \qquad \qquad \text{minutes per day}$$



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
