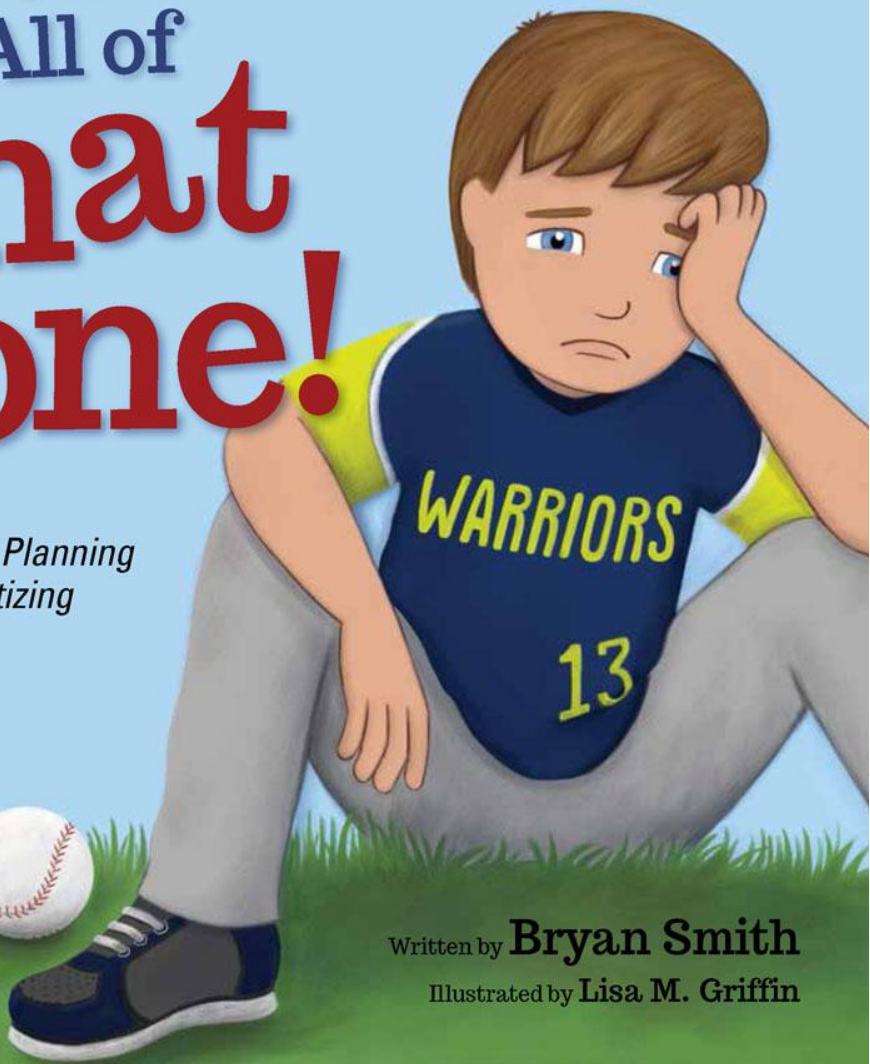

to affect my free time and

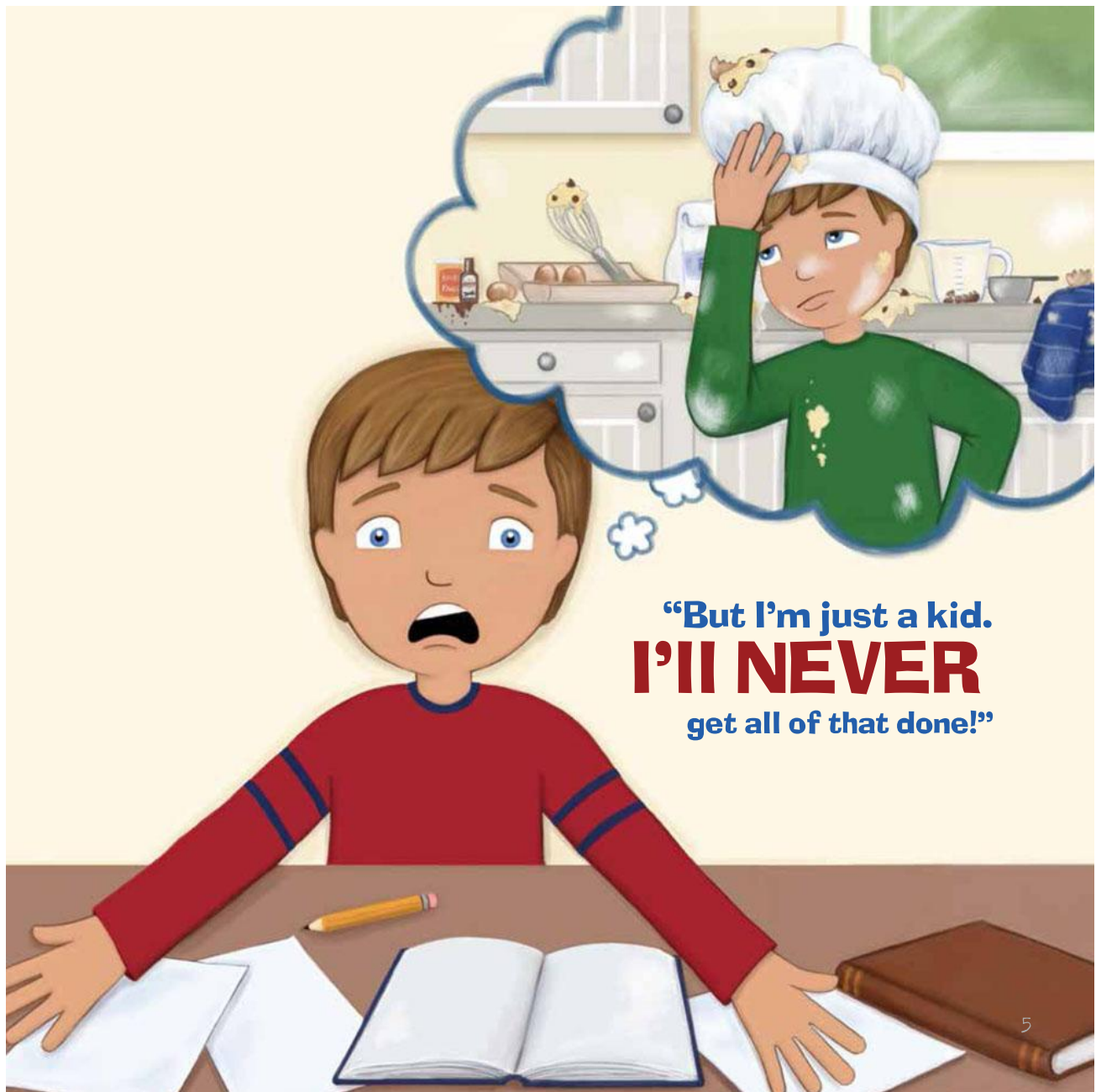
**that's not OK.**
