Teddy was wide awake even before the sun began to smile through the curtains.

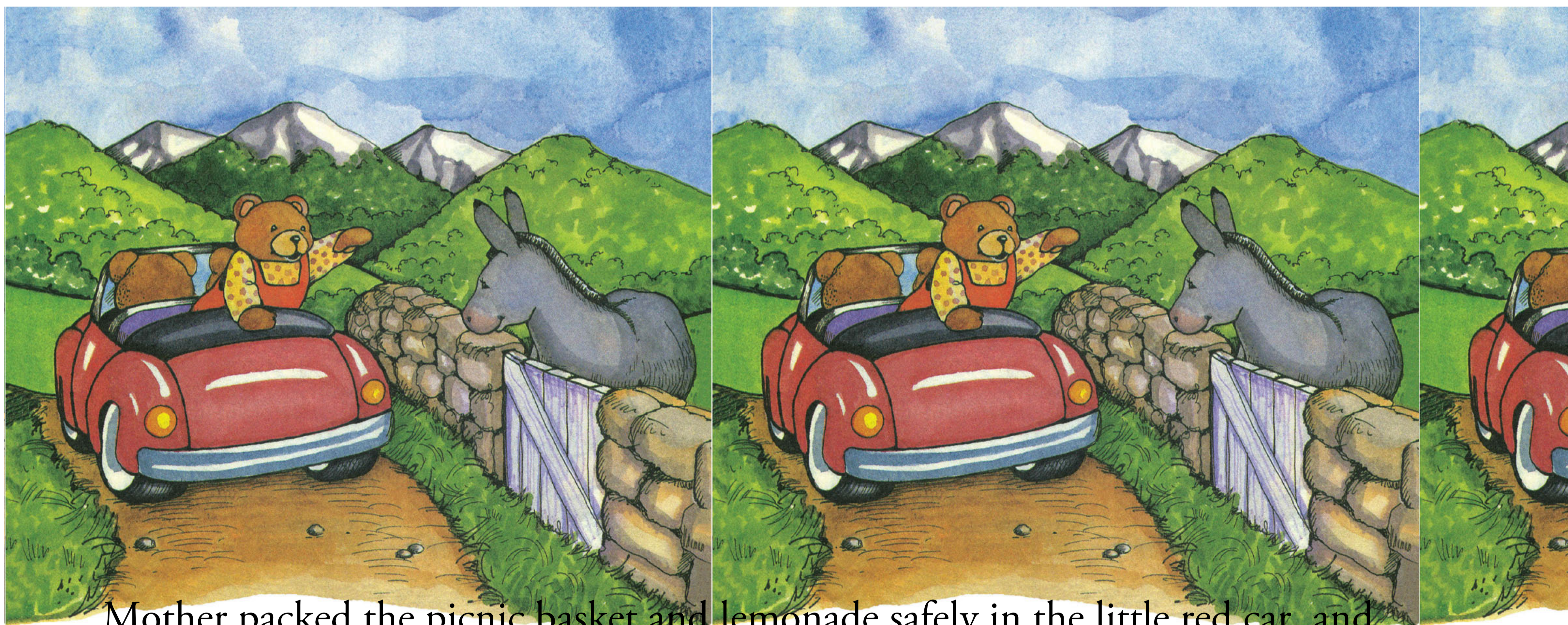
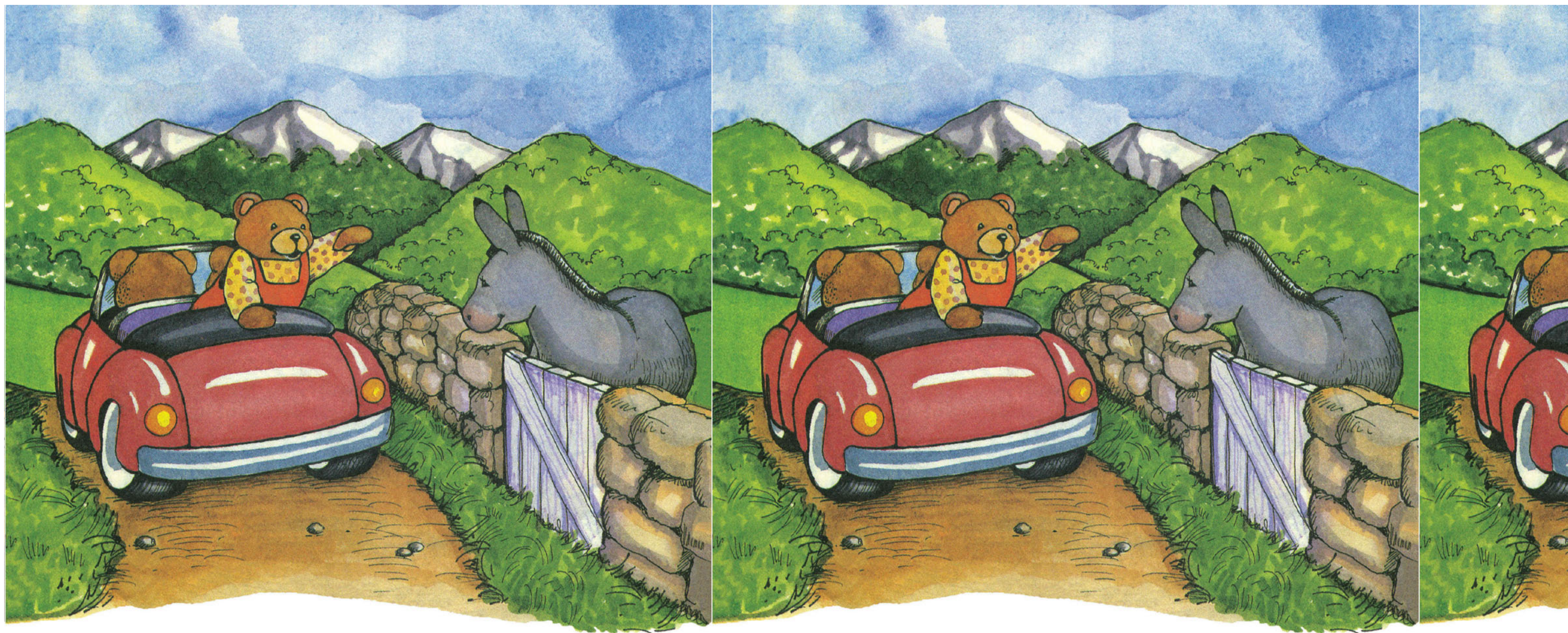
“We’re going to Silver Lake for a picnic,” he called to a speckled bird chirping outside his window. Then he ran downstairs for breakfast.
