Don't forget that setbacks are likely to be experienced by cannabis growers who happen to be newbies. Plants are likely to be lost to either diseases or pets. You will be less affected financially once 2 plants fail to grow as compared to when 15 plants don't grow.

Thinking Big

When getting your space designed, you will not only need to consider the space which such plant is to occupy. In addition to this, have the lights, fans ducting and other things checked out. In other for you to work very well, there need to be plenty of rooms left. It is possible for cannabis plants to double triple themselves at during early flowering stages. This is why your head space needs to be adequate enough.

If you are using a closet, tent or cabinet as a grow room, have it opened. After that, get the plants removed so as to possibly carry out some work on them.
