The host takes you to your table.

Restaurant Workers

The first worker you meet is the **host**, or greeter. The host greets you when you walk in the door. Where would you like to sit? Do you want a seat by the window? Just tell the host. The host will try to find the best table for you. You might have to wait a bit, though.



Many cooks work in a kitchen. The chef is in charge of all the cooks.

A waiter comes to your table and wants to take your order. Look at the **menu**. What would you like to eat? The waiter will tell the workers in the kitchen. They will cook the meal you order.

The head **chef**, or kitchen manager, is in charge of the kitchen. The head chef tells the other chefs, cooks, or kitchen workers what to do. The chef also helps to decide what meals go on the menu.
