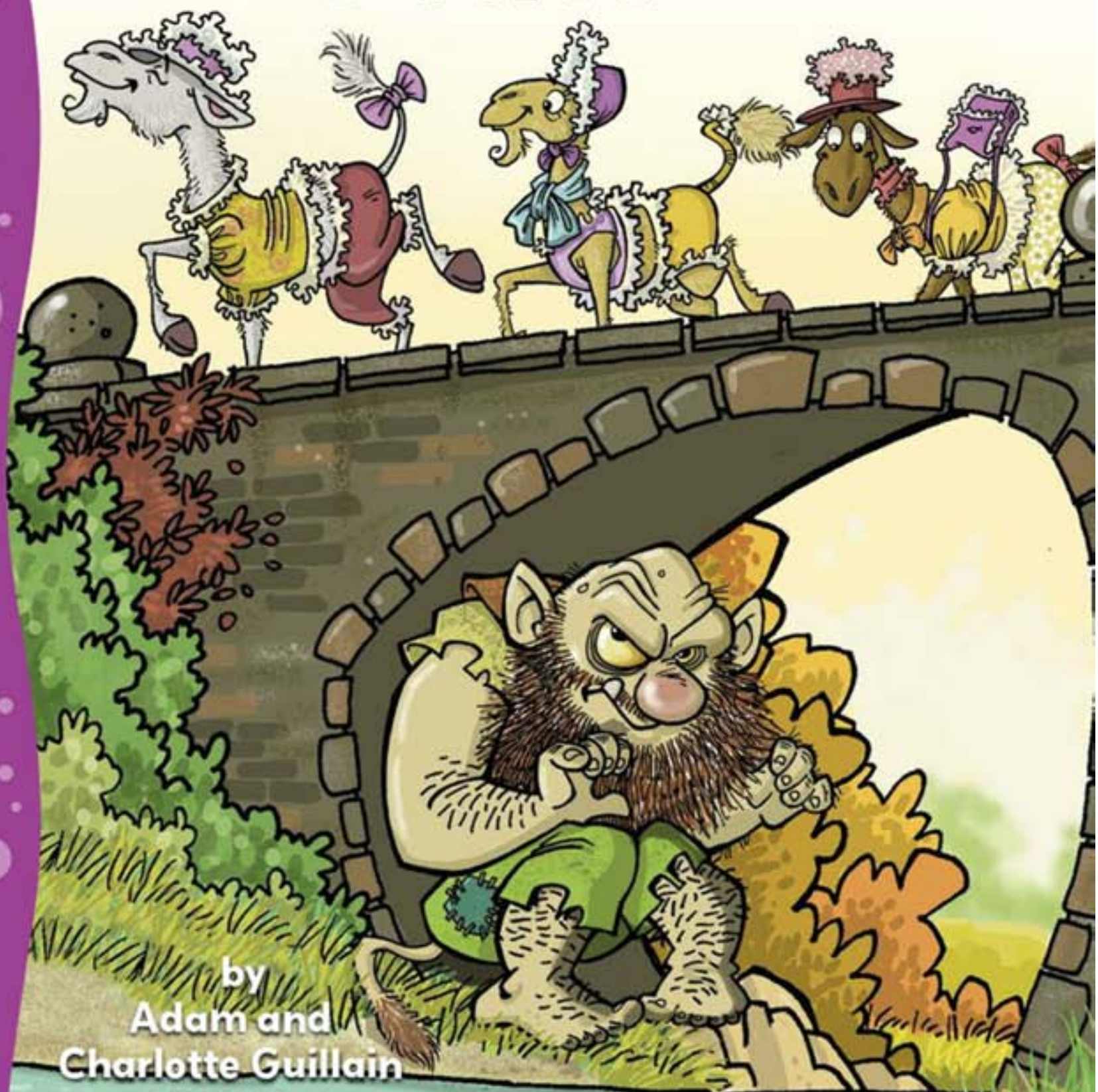

They wore frilly tops.



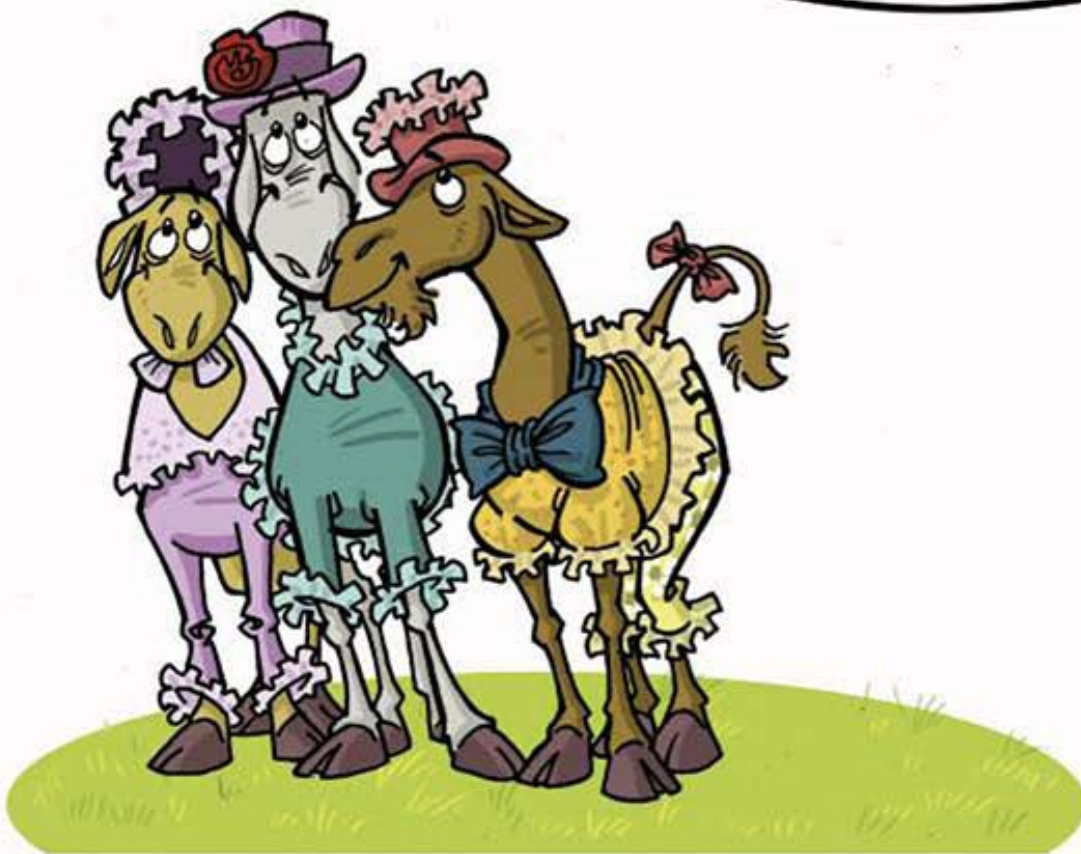
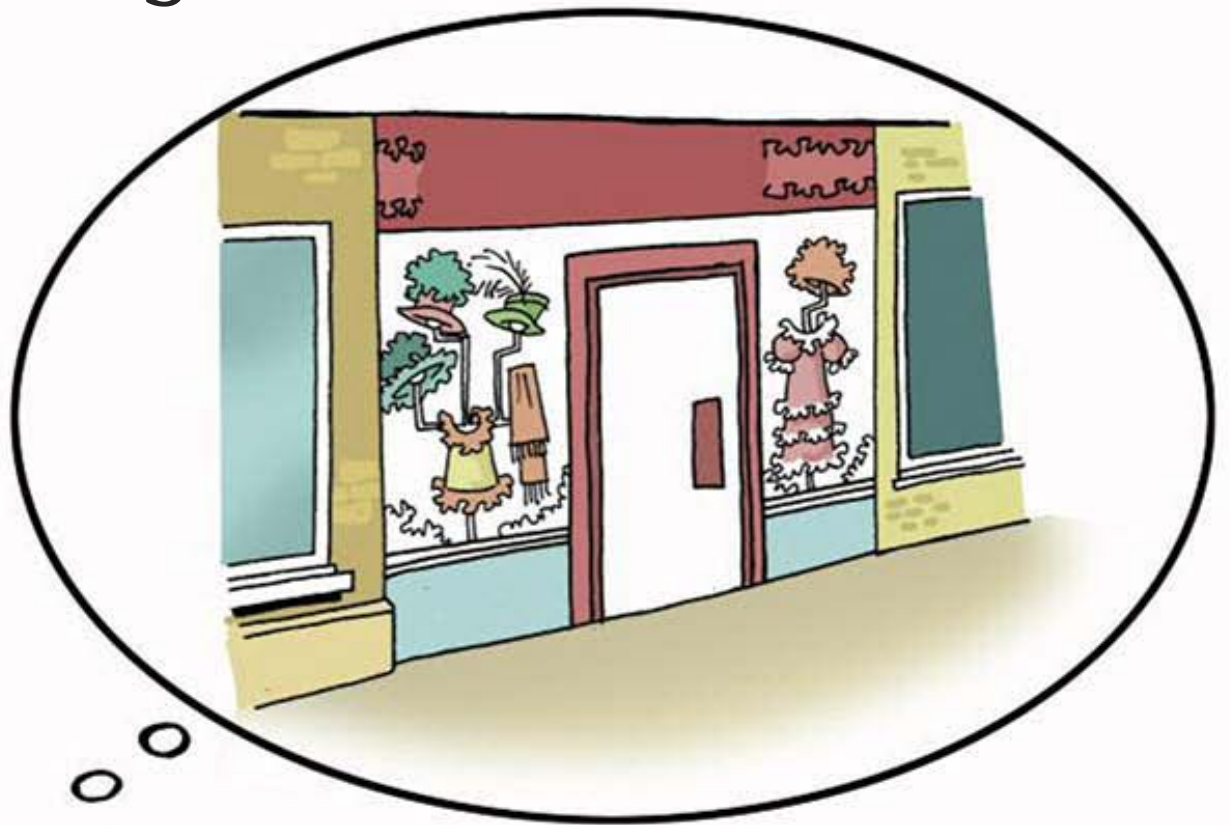
