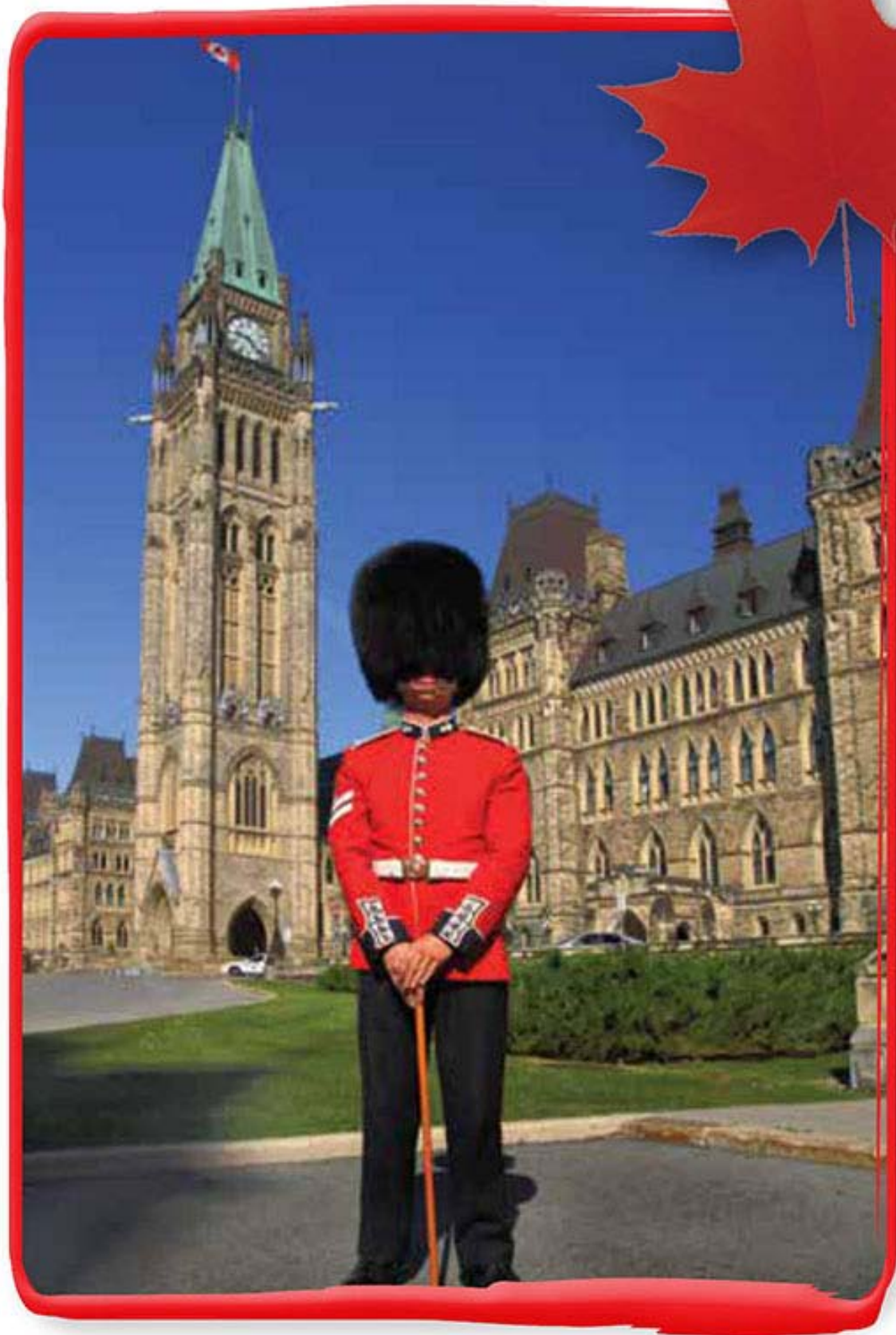

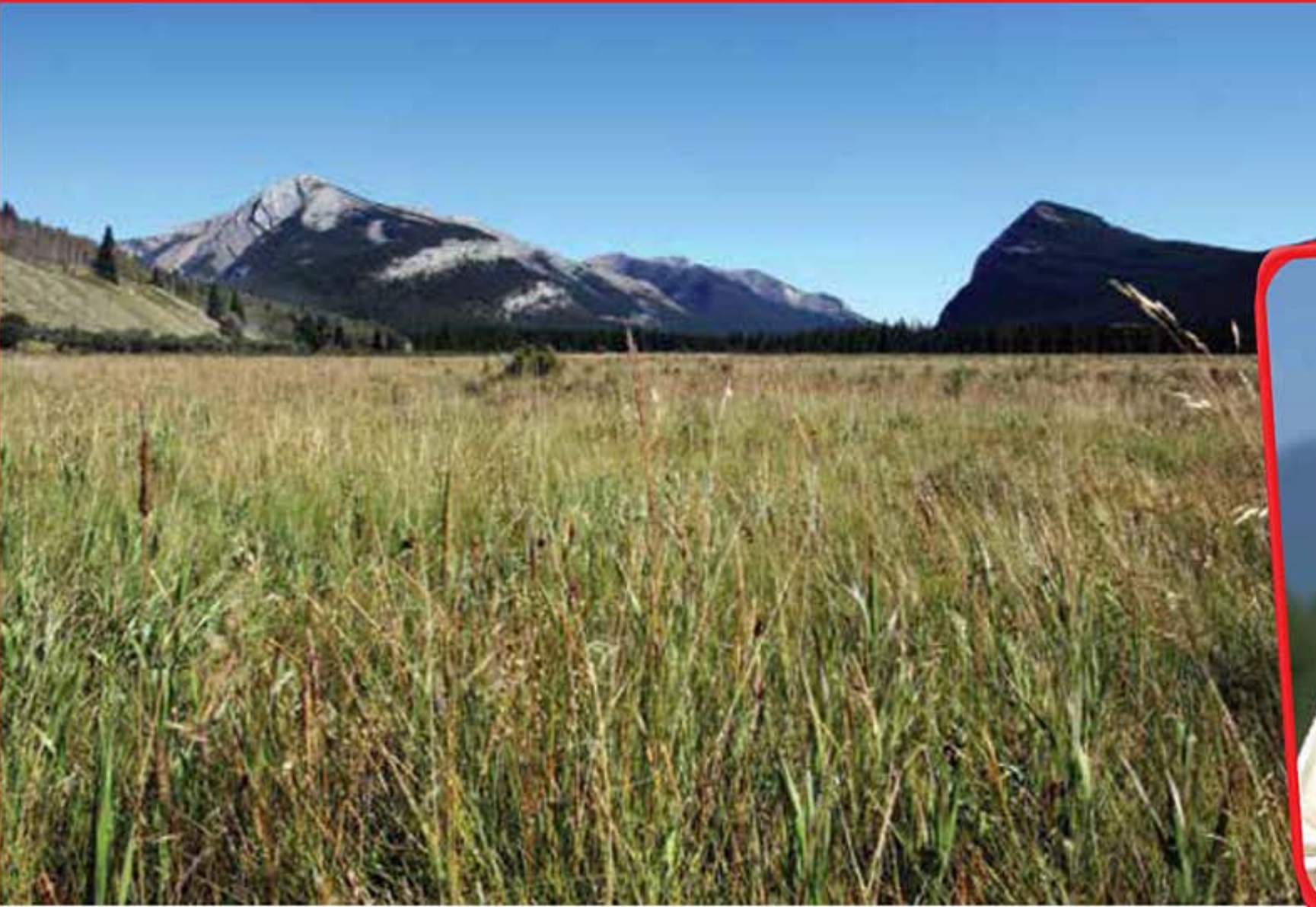

Los primeros habitantes de Canadá fueron los **indígenas**. El nombre de Canadá proviene de una palabra indígena que significa “aldea.”



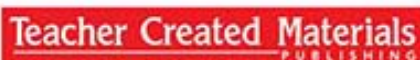
