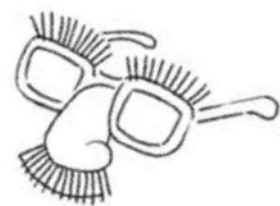

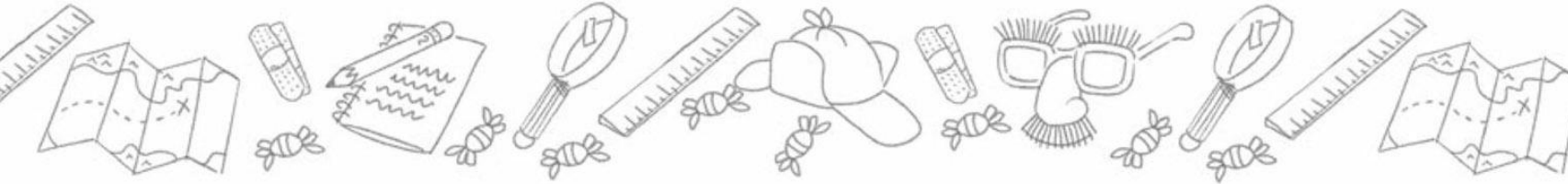

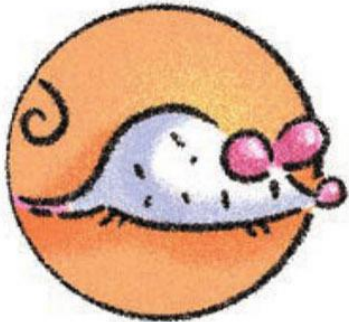
Professor Peach
