- Identify key words in isolation and within text.
- Locate rhyming words: **grow/know to/Do/into**
- Promote writing, drama and art as follow-up activities.

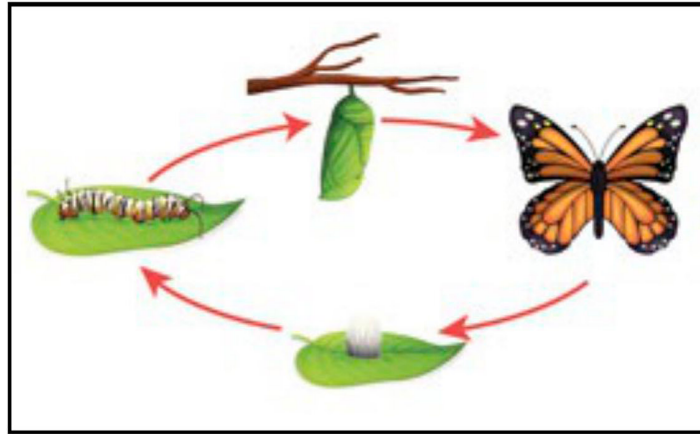
