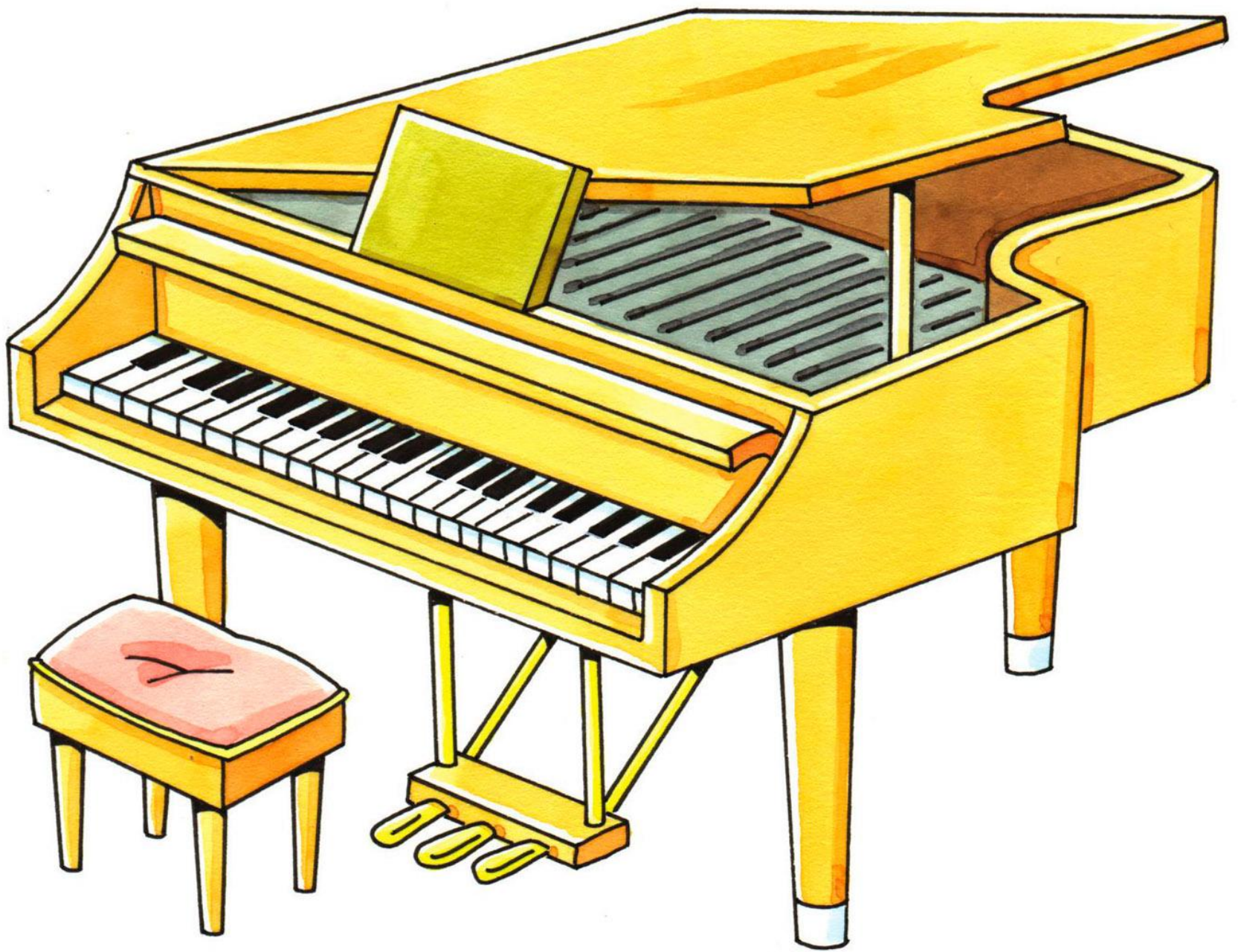


- Use Teacher Talk to stimulate discussion of topic.

- Understand use of punctuation marked in red.
- Match upper and lower case letters (divide flashcards).
- Promote drama, writing or art as follow-up activities.
- Find learning resources to extend and reinforce the literacy strategies in this title @ redrocketreaders.com

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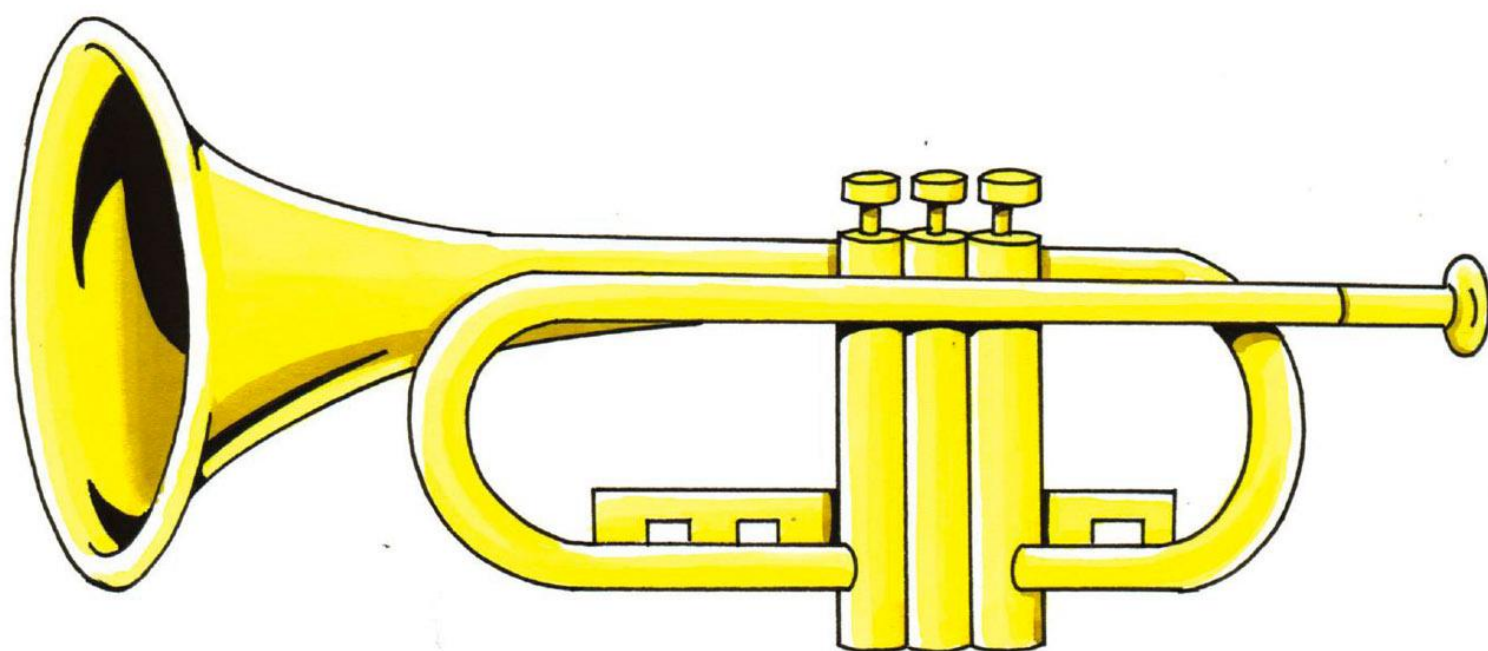
